

## PAVÉ crystal pedicure



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## APPLY IN 4 EASY STEPS

## STEP 1: Begin with a fresh pedicure.



Apply fresh polish. Allow to dry until no longer tacky to the touch. If applying to gel polish, remove inhibition layer and lightly buff to remove the shine.

STEP 2: Apply adhesive.



Apply an even layer of brush on nail adhesive. Be careful not to flood the cuticle and sidewall area. Allow the fumes to evaporate from the adhesive layer. You may lightly fan, but do not allow the adhesive to dry.

STEP 3: Apply appliqués



Peel appliqué from the backing and center on nail, aligning the first row of stones along the free edge of the nail.



Adhere appliqué to the sides of the toe, similar to how you might secure a sculpting form.



Using the fleshy part of your thumb, apply even pressure to the appliqué to ensure the stones are in full contact with the surface of the nail. Use an orangewood stick to apply pressure to the stones near the cuticle and sidewall areas.

STEP 4: Remove appliqué backing





Beginning at one side of the nail, slowly begin peeling the appliqué backing away. If you see stones that are still stuck to the backing, lay the backing back down and press firmly on the stone with the orangewood stick. Repeat this process across the nail as you remove the appliqué backing. If any stones do not adhere, follow the instructions in the troubleshooting guide.

Your client should be advised to treat her new Pavé Crystal Pedicure with care for the next 24 hours while the adhesive continues to fully cure.
